Requirements for travelling with medical oxygen.

Medical oxygen equipment; concentrators, tubing, regulators

Planning a short trip? Visiting loved ones? A medical appointment in the city?

BOC recommends ensuring that you have all the **medical equipment** you need for the duration of the trip **prior** to leaving home.

Here is a list to help you plan your trip.

- Do I have a current copy of my 02 prescription on hand?
- What type of concentrator will I need while I am away?
 - o 5L Stationary concentrator 350watts
 - o 10L Stationary concentrator 600watts *Ensure the power sources available at your destination are suitable for your concentrator requirements.
 - o Portable Concentrators (requires titration with your physician prior to departure)
 *Ensure you have suitable battery backup for portable concentrators and charger accessories.
- Will I be needing cylinders while I am away?
 - o **Do I have the correct safe storage and transport accessories for my trip?** e.g. Carry bag or Trolley
 - Gas cylinder refills
 - Check our store locator on www.boc.com.au or www.boc.co.nz to see where you can access a local BOC site to replenish your cylinder supply when required.
 - *Deliveries may not be available at your destination.
- Do I have enough cannulas and tubing for my whole trip?
 - BOC supply cannulas and tubing during the initial set-up of your concentrator. Be sure to pack your existing tubing OR order more for home delivery well in advance of departure.
 - *Courier deliveries to home can take 5-10 business days

Please contact BOC promptly to organise delivery of any equipment you require prior to leaving home; one less thing to manage as departure date approaches! Please be aware: you will be responsible for all items rented until they are returned to BOC.
