## 1) **COMPONENTS**:

a) Insulation Box



### b) Dry Ice Pellets



#### Warning:

Dry Ice will release a colorless, odorless gas, called carbon dioxide = CO2. Carbon dioxide is heavier than normal air and so will stay on the ground. In large quantities this can lead to a depletion of oxygen in the immediate vicinity that could cause dizziness or faintness in humans. Ensure that any areas where Dry Ice is stored are well ventilated. Dry Ice is extremely cold and should not be touched with the naked skin otherwise severe frostbite and cold burning. Gloves must be worn to handle Dry Ice.

### 3) PICKUP REQUEST

**!!!PLEASE NOTE:** To ensure the cooling of the Dry Ice for the whole transportation please **contact DHL Express** within 12h after receiving the packing (loss of Dry Ice). The Shipment has to be ready 1 hour before pick-up. Dry Ice is only accepted as cooling agent for non dangerous good.
