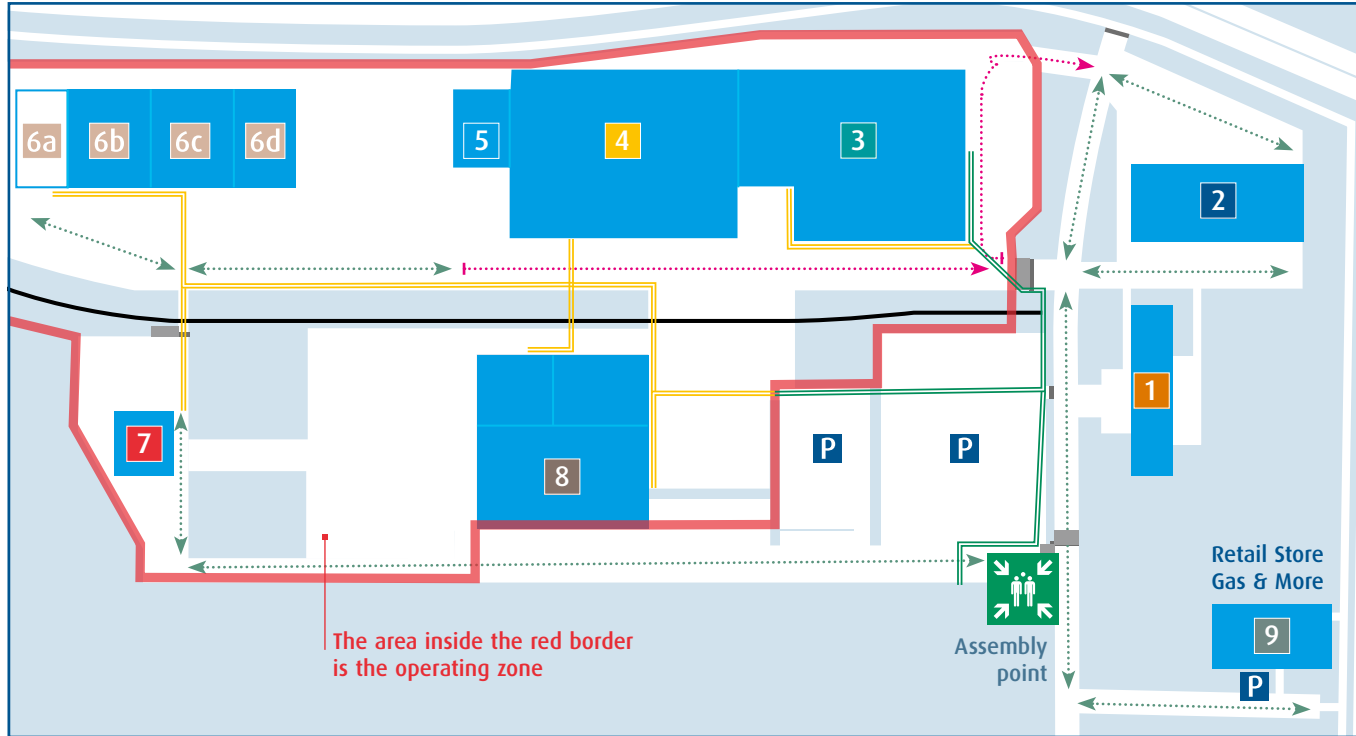


Dagmersellen site plan

General information

Signing in and out:

- Visitors and suppliers should sign in and out at the reception desk in the administration building.
- When signing in, you will be given this information leaflet and a visitor pass. Please wear your pass on top of your clothing so that it is clearly visible.
- Hand your pass back in at reception at the end of your visit.



Please park in the designated visitor parking spaces. Driving through the operating zone is only permitted in exceptional cases for the purpose of handling goods.



The PanGas AG site is monitored using video surveillance.



A maximum speed limit of 20 km/h applies to all vehicles. Your actual speed must be adapted according to the specific conditions in each case.



Photography and filming are not permitted on the PanGas AG site without obtaining consent.



A general smoking ban applies throughout the works premises. Smoking is only permitted in the specially designated zones.



You may only enter the operating zone if you are accompanied by an authorised person or have been given special instructions.



Building 5/hydrogen works: mobile phones prohibited

Safety and conduct regulations in the operating zone

Please stay with your host/guide at all times and follow their instructions.



Please watch out for industrial trucks and other works traffic when using the designated walkways.



Safety shoes must be worn throughout the operating zone. Exceptions → on the green marked walkway by buildings 1-3 and in the office area.



Visitors /suppliers must wear a «visitor's safety vest» or similar high-visibility clothing throughout the operating zone. Exceptions → in the office area and on the green marked walkway (green way).



Rules for specifically designated areas (e.g. the requirement to wear safety helmets) also apply to visitors/suppliers.



When outside the building, pedestrians must stick to the green or yellow marked walkways.



Hi-vis safety vests are a requirement for visitors using the green walkway within the operating zone. They are not required outside the operating zone.



Safety shoes and a «visitor's safety vest» must be worn to use the yellow marked walkway. (Yellow way)



No material or vehicles may be deposited or parked on the marked walkways.

What to do in an emergency

Keep calm → act quickly and rationally. Please also pay attention to the «What to do in an emergency» signs.

First aid kits and defibrillators are available in the individual buildings. There are first aid rooms in building 3 and in the administration building.

Fire/evacuation



In the case of fire, act according to this basic principle: **Raise the alarm → rescue → extinguish**



Please follow the signed emergency exit routes.



In the case of evacuation, please leave the building immediately and go to the designated assembly point.
