

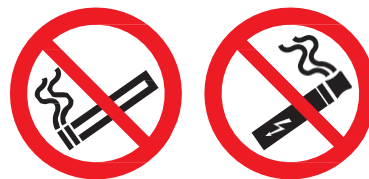


9 mandatory safety rules for container logistics drivers

1. Find out about **escape routes, assembly points**, and the locations of **fire extinguishers**.



2. Smoking is **strictly prohibited**. Exceptions are specially marked areas.



3. Wearing **ankle-high safety shoes, long work pants**, and a **high-visibility vest** is mandatory. Work jackets with reflectors in accordance with EN ISO 20471 are equivalent.



4. **Two wheel chocks** must be used to secure **either the steering or drive axle of the tractor on the driver's side** at the front and rear

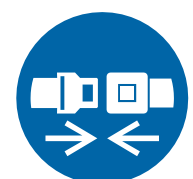


This applies to every vehicle that is loaded and unloaded with a forklift. **Loading and unloading without wheel chocks is prohibited**. Linde can provide these for the duration of loading and unloading at its plants.

5. **Always** use a ladder or a suitable climbing aid to climb up and down the loading area. **Jumping down is strictly prohibited**.

6. **Avoid reversing** if possible. If necessary, ask for instructions.

7. The **seat belt** must be fastened as soon as a vehicle is moved. This also applies to loading and unloading with a forklift truck **without a restraint system or cab**.



8. **Only exit the cab backwards with both hands on the grab handles** and take each step consciously and slowly. Important: Pay attention to the ground!



9. **Always follow the instructions of the factory personnel**.
