9 mandatory safety rules for container logistics drivers

1. Find out about escape routes, assembly points, and the locations of fire extinguishers.







2. Smoking is strictly prohibited. Exceptions are specially marked areas.



- 3. Wearing ankle-high safety shoes, long work pants, and a high-visibility vest is mandatory. Work jackets with reflectors in accordance with EN ISO 20471 are equivalent.







4. Two wheel chocks must be used to secure either the steering or drive axle of the tractor on the driver's side at the front and rear This applies to every vehicle that is loaded and unloaded with a forklift. Loading and unloading without wheel chocks is prohibited. Linde can provide these for the duration of loading and unloading at its plants.

- 5. Always use a ladder or a suitable climbing aid to climb up and down the loading area. Jumping down is strictly prohibited.
- 6. Avoid reversing if possible. If necessary, ask for instructions.
- 7. The seat belt must be fastened as soon as a vehicle is moved. This also applies to loading and unloading with a forklift truck without a restraint system or cab.
- 8. Only exit the cab backwards with both hands on the grab handles and take each step consciously and slowly. Important: Pay

attention to the ground!



9. Always follow the instructions of the factory personnel.
